South Glengarry spends millions each year to provide the services that meet these needs. We raise most of the money for financing these services from the property taxes paid by residents, businesses, farms, etc. Additional funding comes from user fees or non-tax revenue, as well as provincial and federal grants.

Property Taxes

South Glengarry collects property taxes from each property owner. The taxes are calculated by multiplying the assessed value of a property by a tax rate. There are three parts to the tax rate:

- the municipal tax rate, which is set by your local municipal government;
- the county tax rate, which is set by your county Council (featuring two local members); and
- the education tax rate, which is set by the provincial government.
