



**NOTICE OF THE PASSING OF AN INTERIM CONTROL BY-LAW
BY-LAW 77- 20
TO PROHIBIT CANNABIS CULTIVATION, PROCESSING AND
PRODUCTION**

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the Township of South Glengarry passed By-law 2020-041 on the 16th day of November 2020, under Section 38 of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.P.13, as amended.

And take notice that Interim Control By-law 2020-041 will be in effect for a period of one year from the date of passing, lapsing November 16, 2021, but may be extended by Council for an additional one-year period in accordance with Section 38 of the *Planning Act*, or repealed by Council at an earlier date.

And Take Notice that only the Minister may, within 60 days after the date of passing of a by-law under Subsection (1), appeal to the Tribunal, accompanied by the fee required by the Tribunal, by filing with the Clerk of the Municipality a Notice of Appeal, setting out the objection of the By-law and reasons in support of the objection.

Purpose and Effect The purpose of this By-law is to provide the Township with the opportunity to undertake a study to review its land use planning policies pertaining to cannabis cultivation and processing; and to prohibit the use of lands within the Township of South Glengarry for any new cannabis production land uses for a period of one (1) year. This by-law applies to all properties in the Township.
