



South Glengarry Council grants unpaid leave to Frank Prevost

SOUTH GLENGARRY, ON – The Council of the Township of South Glengarry has granted a six-month unpaid leave of absence to Mayor Frank Prevost, effective immediately. Deputy Mayor Lyle Warden will assume the duties of Acting Mayor in Prevost's absence.

In a statement made prior to passing the resolution granting the leave at an emergency Special Meeting, Deputy Mayor Warden stated, "With respect to the recent criminal charges against Mayor Prevost, it is acknowledged that this is a very difficult time for staff, Council and members of the public."

Warden further stated that the resolution granting the leave of absence is deemed to be in the best interest of the staff and residents of the Township of South Glengarry and will allow the day-to-day operations of the Township to remain the focus.

Council additionally acknowledged the significant upset that the charges laid against Prevost may cause to members of the community and staff and urged those who are distressed to utilize community resources.
