**NOTICE OF COMPLETION**

The Township of South Glengarry (Township) completed a Water and Wastewater Servicing Master Plan for the Glen Walter Area in 2022. Following up on the Master Plan's recommendations, the Township intends to proceed with design of a 1,600 m<sup>3</sup> elevated water tank and watermain replacement/ extension/ looping. The Township has completed the Class Environmental Assessment to determine the extra level of detail for designing the new elevated water tank at 6618 Glen Walter Park Road, specifically the height and type of tank, as well as additional site investigations (Natural Heritage Study and Phase 1 & Phase 2 Archaeological Assessment). The recommended solution is to proceed with design and construction of a 52m high composite elevated water storage tank.



The Township has planned this project through a Schedule 'B' process of the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (2023). As such, public and technical agency consultation played a role in developing the recommendations.

A Project File Report documenting the planning process undertaken, details of the study recommendations as well as potential impacts and mitigating measures, has been completed and is being made available for public review. Subject to comments received following this Notice and the receipt of approvals, the Township intends to proceed with design and construction of the recommended project, as outlined in the Project File Report.
