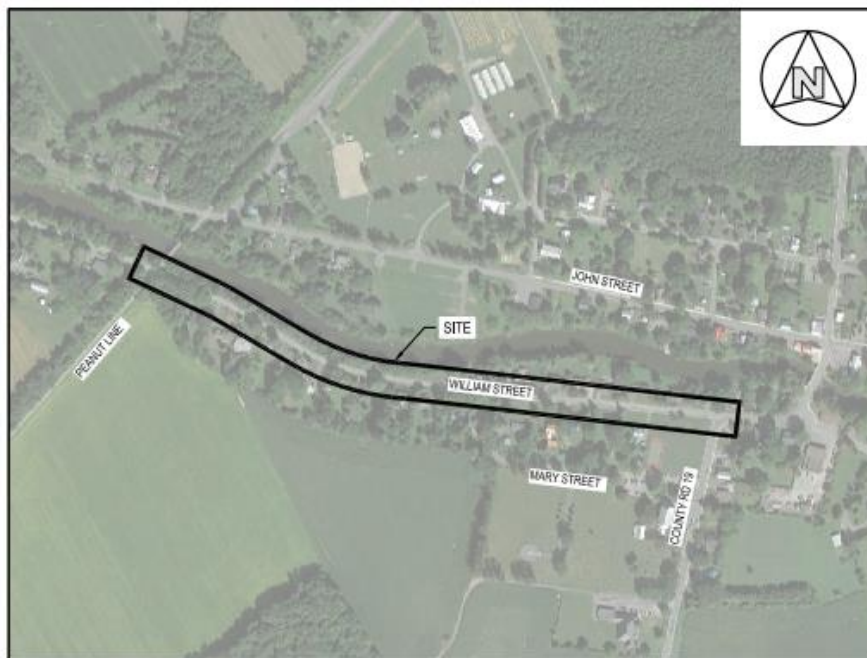


NOTICE

TO PROPERTY OWNERS ON AND IN THE AREA OF WILLIAM STREET

Date: May 1st, 2020

This notice is to advise you of the reconstruction of William Street between SDG County Rd. 19 to the Peanut Line Trail, as delineated in the image below, which will be commencing shortly.



EVB Engineering will be providing full time site supervision and construction administration for the project, which has been awarded to Malyon Excavation Ltd.

Due to the current COVID-19 crisis, there is an inability to host an in-person public meeting at this time, however a digital public meeting is scheduled to be hosted by EVB Engineering on Wednesday May 6th, 2020 at 6:00pm. Project Scope

The project will include a full depth reconstruction of the William St. roadway complete with the following:

- 3.5m (11'6") asphalt lane widths;
- Semi-mountable curb and gutter in locations where properties front roadway;
- Replacement of existing concrete sidewalk;
- New underground storm sewers, catchbasins, and storm laterals;
- New guiderail in locations warranted per MTO Ontario Roadside Safety Manual;
- Reinstatement of driveways disturbed due to construction activities or as required to achieve an acceptable slope, in materials matching existing;
- Reinstatement of grass disturbed due to construction activities with sod;

Construction Schedule

- Construction is scheduled to begin on or around May 11th, 2020.
- The project is scheduled to be "substantially performed" by August 30th, 2020.

Road Access

- During construction it will be necessary to partially close sections of William Street (local traffic only). Temporary full road closures are also to be anticipated at times to allow for the construction of new infrastructure. During these times a detour route will be provided;
- During construction you will be asked to refrain from parking on the road;
- Temporary driveway closures are to be anticipated to allow for the construction of new infrastructure, however the contractor will do everything possible to allow for access to your driveway entrance at the end of each working day.

Please note that residents can expect increased construction traffic and noise during construction. We are sorry for any inconvenience this may cause you, and we would like to thank you in advance for your cooperation.
